“On the Levels: What You Need and What You Need To Move Up” Dressage Symposium with Melonie Kessler

When: December 2-3, 2017

Where: Fletcher Farms, 2021 W. Roderweis Road, Cabot, AR 72023. From Little Rock: Take I-40 East toward Memphis then keep left to take US-67N/US-167N toward Jacksonville. Take Exit 5 toward AR-176/Kiehl Ave, merge onto Landers Rd, and take the ramp toward Kiehl Ave. Turn left onto Indianhead Dr, turn left onto E Kiehl Ave, turn right onto Brockington Rd, then turn right onto Highway 107/AR-107. In about 9 miles, turn right onto Roderweis Road.



Our Presenter: Melonie Kessler is a dressage trainer, clinician, competitor and USEF “S” judge. She has trained and shown horses through Grand Prix earning her USDF Bronze, Silver and Gold medals. She has qualified horses at all levels for regional or national Championships, including Grand Prix. She has over 30 years experience in teaching and training and has ridden with some of the top of the dressage clinicians in the industry. Her program is adapted to the horse and rider at a level comfortable for both, using the training pyramid when teaching. As a clinician, she explains from the judge’s viewpoint the movements, and the way the scores are earned. A belief that a dialogue between the riders, auditors, and herself is important during the clinic to further understand the training process.
