This is a "ride a test" clinic with L-judge Susanne Lauda of Duluth, Georgia. The clinic will be held on September 11, 2017, at two locations. An early morning session will be held at G&H Equestrian Center (3600 Chatfield Road, Bauxite, AR). A mid-day/early afternoon session will be held at Valley View Farm (85 Vilanco Lane, Vilonia, AR).

1. Closing date September 6, 2017. Entries must be postmarked prior to the closing date. Entires may be included with your G&H show entry form. You do NOT have to participate in the ADS show on September 10 to participate in this clinic.
2. Space is limited and will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Please enter ASAP!
3. Riders who are not currently members of ADS are welcome to participate. For insurance purposes, only ADS members, at an ADS-sponsored event, may participate in mounted activities. There are 2 types of memberships. All non-members must complete either an ADS membership form and submit the form and membership dues with this entry form (\$48.00) or pay \$15.00 per day and submit payment with this entry form.
4. Protective headgear and footgear are required at all times while mounted.
5. Original Coggins report within 12 months is required to enter.
6. ADS insurance coverage does not allow dogs, leashed or unleashed, at ADS events.
7. Hours for the clinic will be determined by the number of riders.
