

## Clicker Training Clinic Registration Form

**Warning:** Under Arkansas law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities.

The clinic will be taught by Cindy Martin, Certified Training Partner of the Karen Pryor Academy, and a coach for Alexandra Kurland's online course in Clicker Training for horses.

The first day of the clinic will be an introduction and demonstration of clicker training. A second day is offered for those who want to know more. There will be demos in the barn and arena, and classroom activities. No need to bring your horse, although there are limited openings for those who wish to bring a horse. All riding disciplines welcome!!

Saturday session is 9am – 5pm; Sunday session is 9am – 3pm. Lunch will be provided.

**Directions:** From I-40 West, take Mayflower Exit 135 onto Highway 89S. Travel 7 miles and turn left onto Matt Abbott Road. (There is a large wooden sign at Matt Abbott Road and 89S). Follow the signs to the barn.
