(7) A \$10 late fee applies to each ride scheduled after closing date. (8) A \$5 change fee applies to each change after closing date. (9) Rides may be limited or closed if a show is over subscribed. (10) Grounds fee due for each horse entered, including boarders of host farm. (11) For overnight stabling, contact the host farm owner. (10) Protective headgear & footgear required at all times while mounted. (11) Please wear neat, conservative attire. (12) No dogs allowed. (13) Original Coggins report within 12 months is required to enter the show grounds. (14) Office Fee is non-refundable. (15) Submit an entry form for each horse entered.
